We get the opportunity to play in a large ensemble of mixed brass instruments, and perform a wide spectrum of both brass band and brass ensemble repertoire. The wind orchestra meets for nonresidential courses through the year and plays the full range of wind orchestra music, conducted by Charles Hine.

- Essex Youth Orchestra

The youth orchestras meet termly for residential courses and concerts and regularly tour Europe.
