Essex Youth Jazz Orchestras

The three Essex Youth Jazz Orchestras offer students of various abilities an all-round jazz education, including improvisation, reading written music, and playing in both big and small band styles. If you would like to be considered for membership, please tick the box on the form.

Essex Music Services is the lead organisation in the Essex Music Education Hub, and offers many different opportunities for young musicians:

- Essex Junior Jazz
- Young Essex Jazz
- Essex Youth Jazz Orchestra

These three groups (for students of grade two standard and above) make up the Essex Youth Jazz Orchestras, which are directed by Martin Hathaway and Paul Moylan. The groups meet for monthly rehearsals in Chelmsford, and perform every term. In the summer they either tour to Europe or have a residential summer course.

- Essex Youth Jazz Voices

The EYJV is Essex's new jazz choir which rehearses monthly and performs with the Essex Youth Jazz Orchestra.

- Instrumental Opportunities and Youth Orchestras and Choirs

Essex Music Services also runs the county youth orchestras and choirs, and other groups and workshops by instrument. These groups include brass, strings, wind, and percussion ensembles. Types of opportunities range from one day workshops to residential courses and foreign tours. Please get in touch to find out more.
